Dear Red Team Member.

We hope that you have had a good summer and are prepared for a productive and enjoyable school year. We look forward to meeting you on **\$eptember 9**.

We believe that it is very important that students come to school prepared each day. In order for you to be prepared, it is important that you have the supplies listed below:

The following supplies should be brought to school:

- 2 two inch thick loose-leaf binders (in two different colors)
- 4 section dividers with tabs (two for each binder)
- 2-three hole punches that fit into binders (one for each binder)
- loose-leaf paper (about 100 sheets for each binder)
- 2 zippered pencil cases (with holes) that fit into binders (one for each binder)
- 1 folder with pockets that fits into one of the binders
- Extra graph paper (about 25 sheets)

The following item; should be kept in your pencil cases throughout the school year:

- 12" English / metric ruler
- 6 pens, 6 sharpened pencils (split equally between the two pencil cases)
- 8 various colored highlighters (split equally between the two pencil cases)
- 2 pencil sharpeners (one for each pencil case)
- 2 packages of colored pencils (one pack for each pencil case)
- 1 package of multi-colored fine tip magic markers
- 1 package of reinforcements

- 1 bottle of white out
- 2 alue sticks

The following supplies should be kept at home for future use:

- Fine tip magic markers (1 package)
- small protractor
- a compass
- graph paper (1 package)
- 2 packages of blue or black pens
- 2 packages of pencils, sharpened
- 500 lined 3 ½ in. x 5 in. cards (stored at home)
- an extra three hole punch for binder
- 500 sheet package of loose-leaf paper
- pocket size dictionary/thesaurus
