morphic lens, the Miracle Mirror Screen, stereophonic sound and a new four-track single film projection.

The anamorphic lens restores to its original shape an image previously distorted in filming. This lens makes it possible for a 35 mm. camera to "reach out" to each side, as the eye does, and "compresses" a wide angle scene into a narrow strip of film. When this film is projected through a compensating lens it spreads the image horizontally.

The first motion picture to be shown in Cinemascope is going to be "Hell and High Water." It will star Richard Widmark, Bella Darvi, Victor Francen, Cameron Mitchell, Gene Evans and David Wayne.
