morphic lens, the Miracle Mirror Screen, stereophonic sound and a new four-track single film projection.

The anamorphic lens restores to its original shape an image previously distorted in filming. This lens makes it possible for a 35 mm. camera to "reach out" to each side, as the eye does, and "compresses" a wide angle scene into a narrow strip of film. When this film is projected through a compensating lens it spreads the image horizontally.

The first motion picture to be shown in Cinemascope is going to be "Hell and High Water." It will star Richard Widmark, Bel-la Darvi, Victor Francen, Cameron Mitchell, Gene Evans and David Wayne.
