Intending to make a strong bid for the county championship, Sewanhaka's track and field men won six and tied for first in another, to win the Sewanhaka Relays at Floral Park on Thursday, April 1.

By scoring in every event, with the exception of broad jump, Sewanhaka scored 41 points and was followed by Mephram, 29; Chaminade, 23; Manhasset, 14; Freeport, 11; and St. Mary's, 3. Sewanhaka took the sprint medley (1:43.3), two mile (8:56.1)

—distance medley (8:35), 480 shuttle hurdles (1:00.5), and concluded with an excellent performance in shot put (164'2"); discuss (470'1"), and broad jump, (21'), which it shared first with Mempham.
