J. Wilkinson States Rules Of Driving

When learning to drive any car other than the driver education car under the instructor's supervision, a learner's permit is necessary. While driving with a permit, the learner must be under a licensed driver's supervision: junior operator or chauffeur.

At the age of sixteen, the junior operator's license may be obtained, but may be used only during daylight hours. However, the exception to the rule is if the driver is attending classroom instruction at school during the evening. If you are at a function in the daylight and it is dark when you leave, you are an unlicensed driver if you drive home; if picked up, your license may be suspended. A junior operator may drive at night only if he is accompanied by a person eighteen years or older who has a valid New York State driver's license. A junior operator's license is not valid in New York City, or in any state that does not recognize said license.

At the age of seventeen, the operator's license may be obtained by passing a qualified course in driver education. At Paul D. Schreiber High School the driver education course must be passed with an eighty-five per cent average or better to obtain an operator's license at seventeen. Driving at night and within New York City limits is permitted with this license. An operator's license may also be obtained by a person eighteen years or over; there are no restrictions on this license unless so stated when obtained.
