Port Gains Narrow Lead

Using the same strategy as in the previous Hicksville game, Coach Costello began the second quarter with R. Hull, A. Pollock, E. Lloyd, R. Musselwhite and P. Nuzzolese. After six minutes of playing, they increased Port's lead to six points.

The first five, now well rested, finished the remaining two minutes of the half and left with Port ahead 29-26. The third period saw the Costellomen score 18, John Schermerhorn and Bob Metzger shared the honors with six tallies apiece.

Cliffmen Cut Port's Lead

Sea Cliff made its bid for victory in the final eight minutes. At one point, the Blue and White's lead was cut to a single point. Responsible for this rally was the Cliffmen's high scorer, Duffy, who scored twelve points in the last period. Ron Francis, also on the Maroon, hit on three long jumpshots and tallied seven points in that quarter.
