In France he was Monsieur Brush; but the Germans were his bane. They always called him Herr Brush, which filled his heart with pain.

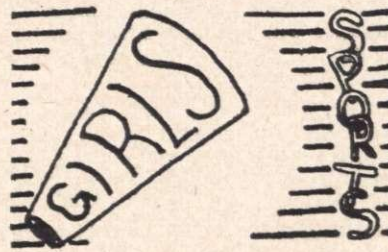
Player of Week
