Bouncing back from their defeat at the hands of Garden City two weeks ago, the Port baseball team outslugged Manhasset, 13-9 on the losers' diamond. The Indians got off to an early two-run lead but the Port batters came back almost as quickly with ten runs in three innings to put the game on ice for Paul Nuzzolese, who had relieved starter Bob Dohm. Besides being credited with the win, Nuzz collected three hits, including a home run. During the course of the game Port slammed out seventeen hits, highlighted by three four-baggers. Bobby Dell hit the first one and Lou Dileo preceded Nuzz's blast with one of his own in the third inning.

A Pitchers' Nightmare

Manhasset used only two pitchers against Port but they might as well have used a dozen as the Blue & White batters hit almost anything and everything thrown. Cifarelli, Dohm, and Newman came up with singles. Dell and DiLeo each collected another single apiece to score

three runs. To round out the day's slugging contest, Ron Musselwhite banged out three singles.

An Important Win

Port played perhaps their best game to-date two weeks from last Monday when they defeated Mineola 7-0, on the losers' field. At least the game was an important one for Port as they defeated second place Mineola for the second time this season. Joe Rezek was the man who held the dangerous Maroons scoreless as he scattered four hits during the seven innings.

Scoreless Deadlock Is Broken

Capitalizing on two walks and an error Port pulled ahead for good in the fourth inning by scoring two runs. Pete Fatizzi's single brought in the winning markers. In the sixth inning Port scored two more times on singles by Dick Marra and Howie Gibbons and a base-clearing double by Jimmy Gilbert. To add a little more insult to injury, Port scored three more times in the last inning on singles by Ron Musselwhite and Lou Dileo and a triple by Paul Nuzzolese.

Repeat Performance

Two weeks ago Friday, Port met Manhasset for the second time this season and for the second time they pounded out sev-

enteen hits. Port won the contest easily 11-0, as Paul Nuzzolese limited the Indians to just four hits while he himself collected four hits. Port got off to a flying start as they scored four runs in the first inning. Ron Musselwhite, Bob Dell, Dick Marra, Lou DiLeo, and Bob Dohm all hit safely in that inning. Musselwhite, Dell and Marra got additional hits later in the game. Joe Newman picked up a single and Bob Dohm singled two more times to complete the batting details.

Port Sneaks By Glen Cove

Port successfully completed another hurdle in its drive for its first baseball championship team in almost thirty years by defeating a stubborn Glen Cove team by a score of 3 to 1 a week ago Tuesday on the losers' diamond. Joe Rezek turned in an-

other fine pitching performance in limiting a good hitting Cover team to just five hits. Joe had an amazing strike-out percentage in the game, striking out sixteen of a possible twenty-one outs.

Rezek tripled to lead off the third inning. But his teammates could not bring him across the plate. Port finally scored in the middle innings when singles by Pete Fatizzi, Lou DiLeo, and Frank Cifarelli resulted in two runs. In the seventh Dickie Marra blasted a triple and scored on the play on a throwing error.
